

WHAT ARE INTEGERS?

A Middle School Guide

INTEGERS are **WHOLE NUMBERS** that can be **POSITIVE, NEGATIVE, or ZERO**. No fractions! No decimals!

NEGATIVE INTEGERS (-)

Examples: -1, -2, -5, -10, -100
Less than zero. The "opposites" of counting numbers.



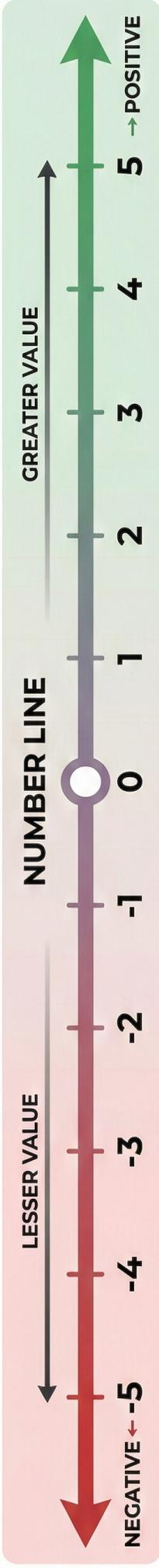
ZERO (0)

Neither positive nor negative.
The center point.



POSITIVE INTEGERS (+)

Examples: 1, 2, 5, 10, 100
Greater than zero.
Also known as "counting numbers".

REAL-WORLD EXAMPLES

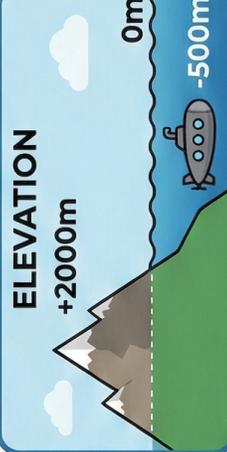
TEMPERATURE

-10°C Negative



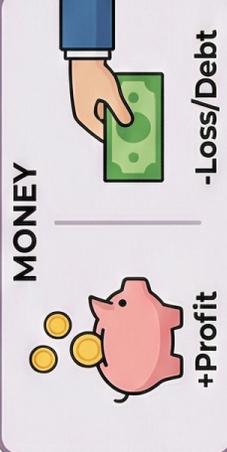
ELEVATION
